







- "Adopt an Island" Program




Existing Zoning in Round-a-Bout



Proposed Round-a-Bout Community Commercial Zone

- "Village" inspired design that features landscaping, walkways, decorative lighting, park benches and a "hometown" look and feel.
- Create a neighborhood friendly retail area characterized by streetscape design and landscaping that visually compliments and better serves the needs of residential area.
- Currently 5 properties are zoned C-C (Community-Commercial) in this area.
- Propose a new zoning district for REP "Round-a-Bout Community Commercial Zone"
- Area residents will benefit from the sense of community created by an environmentally sensitive construction with a pedestrian friendly streetscape design where area residents will regularly encounter each other and walk to neighborhood shops, etc.

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5 Existing commercially properties: existing active

Ideas for Proposed Uses within the Round-a-Bout Area:

- Small restaurants (excluding drive-in fast food service).
- Boutiques, shops, bakery, coffee shop.
- Personal service establishments such as barber shops, hair salons, spas, bicycle shops, shoe repair shops etc.
- Office Use including legal, medical, doctors, dentists or other health care practitioners.
- Residential and/or Mixed Use (residential over commercial).
- Other (ideas from residents).
