- Food Choices: When a trip cancellation occurs and the spot is filled, the senior must accept the selected food choice due to restaurant requirements.
- Any positive or negative feedback on trips should be reported to the chaperone assigned to the trip.
- Chaperone will have "surveys" available for your comment upon request.
- All trips are all inclusive which includes ticket cost, bus driver gratuity, taxes/gratuity at restaurant, etc.
- The Town of Cortlandt pays for the bus cost which varies depending on the trip from \$900 to \$2,500 a day.
- The culmination of trips has been thoughtfully crafted with ideas from the members and surveys distributed to members.
- Many venues require full payment many months in advance of the actual trip, therefore making it necessary to open those early.
- Cash or checks made payable to "Town of Cortlandt" will be accepted as forms of payment. If paying by check for two trips, please write out 2 separate checks.
