We will be using the lottery system for the trips listed on this page. They are open to Town of Cortlandt residents 60+. Once you complete a registration form with your information place it in the trip specific lockbox on the front counter. (Each trip will have a designated lottery box.)

- Each senior should complete a form for each trip.
- Each couple should complete a form for each trip.
- Each senior with a caregiver should complete a form for each trip.
- Each senior may sign up with a Town of Cortlandt travel companion. Each of you needs to fill out a form (only one chance at lottery).

The trip submissions will be accepted now through the lottery deadline.

**THIS MEANS YOU CAN REGISTER FOR ANY TRIPS AT ANYTIME NOW THROUGH THE LOTTERY DEADLINE.**

If your lottery registration form is picked, you will be notified and payment will be due within 5 business days. Once trip is full, names will continue to be drawn and placed on a waiting list (in case people cancel). Any trip that requires a food choice will be collected with payment.

Harlem is one of New York City's most interesting neighborhoods. Located in upper Manhattan at the top of Central Park. It was founded by the Dutch as a farming village in the 1600's with shifts in the population occurring over time, including Jewish and Italian immigrants of the 19<sup>th</sup> century and the Great Migration, which attracted an astonishing array of black writers, artists and scholars and led to Harlem Renaissance of the 1920's and 30's.

The first stop is the famed Apollo Theater where in 1934, the Original Wednesday Amateur Night began and quickly became the leading showcase for many young talented new performer's. such as 15year old Ella Fitzgerald. We'll take a guided tour of this famed theater, with behind-the-scenes access and stories about Apollo legends like James Brown, Stevie Wonder, Mary J. Blige and more.

After the tour, we'll stop for lunch with the "Queen of Soul Food" at Sylvia's Restaurant. A true Harlem icon, Sylvia Woods purchased the "dinette" in 1962. It has since flourished into a family-owned enterprise and has been serving authentic soul food for more than 55 years. Our meal is served family-style, and includes Sylvia's World Famous BAR-B-Que Ribs, Southern Fried Chicken, Three Cheese Baked Macaroni, Collard Greens and Garden Salad. Served with Sylvia's Uptown Iced Tea and Peach Cobbler for dessert.

We will then meet a local guide for a riding tour of historic Harlem, with sights such as Grant's Tomb, Morningside Heights and the tree-lined streets of Sugar Hill District. Explore the rich past and vibrant streets of this celebrated New York neighborhood.
