Mr Kehoe and Members of the Planning Board:

Please find enclosed our application for an outdoor beer garden at Hemlock Hill Farms. The beer garden is proposed to operate Thursday 4pm to 9pm, Friday to Saturday, noon to 10pm, and Sunday noon to 8pm.

Parking for 100 cars is proposed in the existing field to the north which will be accessed through an existing lane which will be widened to accommodate 2 way traffic in and out of the field.

The "beer garden" is proposed for the existing field opposite the stucco residence and store and will include outdoor picnic tables, beer barrels, a food service trailer, a beer service trailer, a trailer with lavatories, a small outdoor stage, and string lights to be suspended from new telephone poles. Occupancy is not to exceed 200 people which is limited by parking and number of bathrooms provided. A new split rail fence is proposed to be installed around the field with access off of the existing store parking lot. The proposed beer garden will be screened from the road by the existing cornfield which is to remain.
