Proposed Action: Port Cortlandt Development

NOTICE TO INVOLVED AGENCIES THAT LEAD AGENCY MUST BE DESIGNATED WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF October 5, 2020.

This Notice is issued pursuant to Part 617.6 of the implementing regulations pertaining to Article 8 (State Environmental Quality Review Act) of the Environmental Conservation Law to designate a lead agency.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The proposal is for zoning text and zoning map amendments that would permit a new port and wind turbine manufacturing facility on approximately 54 acres of a 99 acre parcel of land owned by the Town of Cortlandt (tax parcel ID 43.13-1-3) in the hamlet of Verplanck, Town of Cortlandt, Westchester County. AKRF, Inc. is the proponent of the proposal ("Proponent"). The Proposed Action would include 1) the conveyance of the Town owned parcel to an entity associated with the proponent; 2) the adoption of zoning text and map amendments that would permit the construction of a new port, associated manufacturing facility, and areas designated for outdoor storage and surface parking (the "Proposed Project"). The Project Site is currently vacant, owned by the Town of Cortlandt, and generally bounded by Broadway to the east, 11th Street to the south, the Hudson River to the west, and the Village of Buchanan municipal boundary to the north. The Proponent has posited that an off-shore wind manufacturing facility would provide supply chain resources for the wind energy industry, generate local jobs and partially offset tax revenue and job losses associated with the impending closure of the nearby Indian Point Energy Center (IPEC). To develop the Site as proposed, the Applicant has petitioned the Town Board for amendments to the Town's Zoning Map and Zoning Ordinance, and reviewing the Proponent's site plan would be part of the environmental review process. Proponent has indicated that it is interested in acquiring other neighboring properties.

LEAD AGENCY DESIGNATION

Under the applicable standards of SEQR 6 NYCRR Part 617.6(b), the Town of Cortlandt Town Board concludes that it should be designated as the lead agency in the coordinated environmental review of the proposed action. IF YOU DO NOT RESPOND WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS, IT WILL BE INTERPRETED AS CONSENT THAT THE TOWN OF CORTLANDT TOWN BOARD SERVE AS LEAD AGENCY. YOU WILL CONTINUE TO BE NOTIFIED OF SEQR DETERMINATIONS AND ANY LATER PROCEEDINGS AND HEARINGS, AS PROVIDED BY LAW.
